- ❖ The conference materials will be compiled into an electronic collection with an assigned Universal Identification Number (ISBN) and a Digital Object Identifier (DOI).
- ❖ Certificates for conference participants will be sent to the email address provided in the application form.
 - **❖ Languages of the conference:** *Ukrainian, Polish, English, German.*

Technical requirements for formatting conference materials:

Articles (abstracts) should be provided in an electronic version in MS Word format. The file should be named after the last name of the first author, for example: "Karpenko_MFK_21.03.2024".

The article (abstracts) should be structured as follows: abstract and keywords in Ukrainian and English; the content is divided into: statement of the problem, analysis of the latest research and publications, formulation of the goal, presentation of the main material, conclusions and prospects for further scientific research, a list of used sources in the order of reference by text in accordance with the requirements of APA. References to sources in the text are mandatory.

Articles written in foreign languages (English, German, Polish) with a scientific and professionally done translation are welcome.

Scientific abstracts should have a length of 5 pages of printed text, while articles are recommended to be between 7 to 10 pages of printed text, all in A4 format. All margins should be set at 2 cm. The font for the text is Times New Roman, size 12, with a line spacing of 1.5, and a

paragraph indent of 1.25 cm. Adhering to these guidelines is crucial to meet standards and ensure readability and proper evaluation of the work.

All figures contained in the abstracts should be created using graphic editors compatible with the MS Word text editor. Formulas are to be crafted in the MS Equation formula editor. Each figure must be captioned, and tables should have titles. If there are multiple figures and tables, they should be sequentially numbered with Arabic numerals and placed in line with the main text.

Tables should be created only in portrait orientation. Explanations for figures and titles for tables should be centered.

For example: Figure 1 – Stages of Implementing Innovative Technologies (font size 9, bold). Table 1 – Indicators... (font size 10, the word "Table" in light italics, title in bold, regular font).

Under tables and figures, the sources of their origin are provided in italics, for example:

1. Figure 1 – Quality requirements for new biodegradable materials, being introduced into production

The title of the article (abstract) is printed in uppercase letters at the center, separated by one line below; then the author's name (-s), academic degree, academic title, name of the educational institution, email address at the center in italics; then, on the next line - the text of the abstract without line breaks. At the end – **LIST OF USED SOURCES.**

References in the text to sources must be enclosed in square brackets according to commonly accepted requirements.

Responsibility for the content of materials rests with their authors.
